THE TOUR

We'll start off in the ancient and colorful city of Porto, then wind our way through beautiful country to Barcelos, famous for its market and Portuguese grilled chicken!

Then we'll head over to Braga, where we'll visit the spectacular Bom Jesus church on a mountain overlooking the town.

From there we'll make our way up to Valenca and Tui, two medieval fortified towns straddling opposite sides of the river that separates Portugal from Spain. This area is famous for it's *Vinho Verde*, or Green Wine. Delicious!

Then we'll walk through Celtic-influenced Galicia up to Santiago, to arrive in time to join in the city's unique Easter celebrations.

The walk will be relatively flat – 240kms – winding in and out of small villages through some of Europe's most spectacular countryside, following the age-old pilgrim path from Portugal to Santiago.

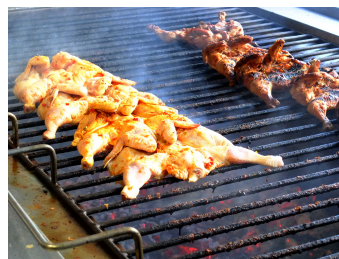
Each night we'll stay in comfortable 3 Star Hotel accommodation, where possible - or Casa Rurales. And we'll enjoy the local wines and cuisine.

There will be a van traveling with us at all times to transport packs, if needed, and pilgrims too if they don't wish to walk. The van will have drinks and snacks on board. Bill Bennett will give a photographic tutorial each day, and will be on hand to give advice and tips during the walk.

Sister Clare will be available for Centering Prayer sessions, and counseling.

Jennifer Cluff will be available for spiritual guidance.

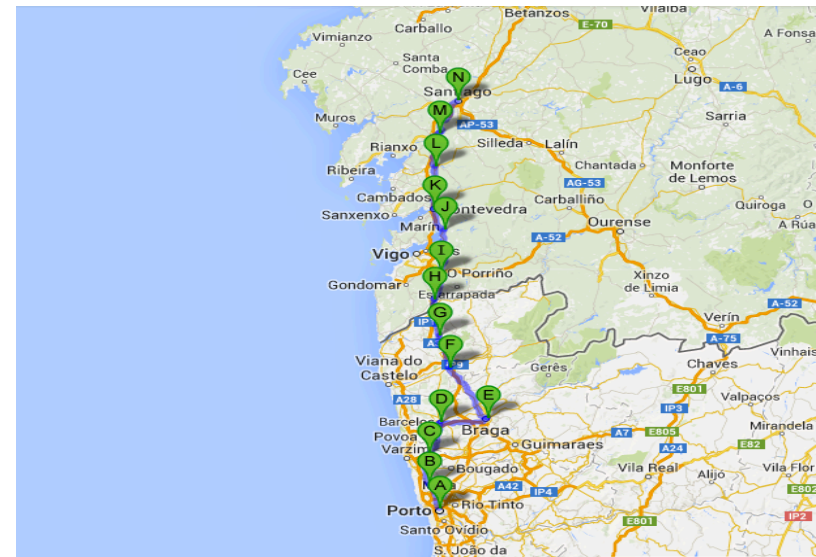

 Day 6 - Ponte do Lima to Rubias (18kms)
 Day 7 - Rubias to Tui (20kms)
 Day 8 - Tui to O Porrino (16kms)
 Day 9 - O Porrino to Arcade (22kms)
 Day 10 - Arcade to Pontevedra (11kms)
 Day 11 - Pontevedra to Caldas de Reis (24kms)
 Day 12 - Caldas de Reis to Padron (18kms)
 Day 13 - Padron to Santiago de Compostela (24kms)

1. Deposit: A deposit of US\$400 is required at time of booking. **2. Cancellation:** If the booking is cancelled up to January 1st, 2014, the deposit will be refunded. After January 1, 2014 if the booking is cancelled there is no refund of deposit. Travellers are advised to take out travel insurance to cover cost of cancellation in the case of emergency or health issue. **3. Onward costs:** Travellers are required to cover the costs of onward or return travel, for instance back to Porto. Trains and buses are readily available, at minimal cost. **4. Cancellation of tour:** Bill Bennett reserves the right to cancel the tour. If so, all monies collected will be refunded in full. Bill Bennett undertakes to provide all services listed above. **5. Tour Leader:** In the event of a personal or family illness, or other circumstance where Bill Bennett cannot lead the tour, the tour participants will be offered a replacement tour leader, or full cancellation at no charge. **6.
